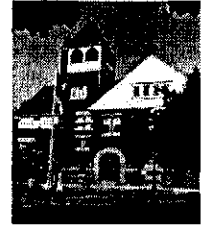

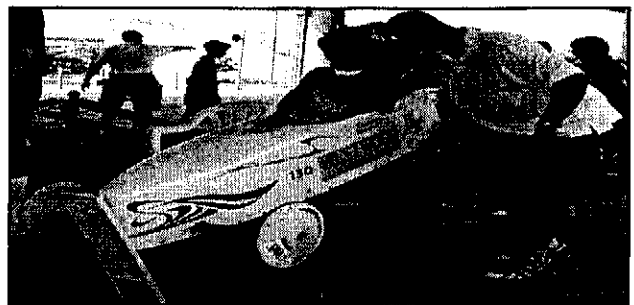

### Sewer Project is Being Planned for Westwood Northern Area

The Metropolitan Sewer District of Greater Cincinnati (MSDGC) is designing a \$14 million sewer separation project to reduce combined sewer overflows (CSOs) into local waterways. Called the Westwood Northern Bundle, the project will affect neighborhoods immediately west of Westwood Northern Blvd., roughly between North Bend Rd. and Montana Ave.

CSOs occur when the combined sewers underlying these neighborhoods are overwhelmed by storm water during wet weather. When this happens, excess wastewater is released into nearby streams and creeks to ease pressure on the system and prevent basement back-ups. MSDGC plans to address the CSOs by separating surface water runoff from sanitary sewage. This will involve installing a second sewer roughly along the same alignment as the existing combined sewer. One sewer will be dedicated to storm water runoff and the other will be dedicated to sanitary waste.

Most construction will take place in the public right of way, however some work will need to be done on private property. Once affected properties are identified, MSDGC will notify and work closely with the property owners.

The project's design phase is expected to continue until late 2012 and construction should begin soon after. Construction will be complete no later than mid 2017.

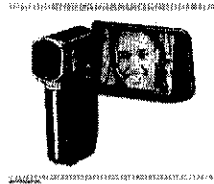

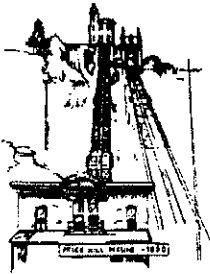

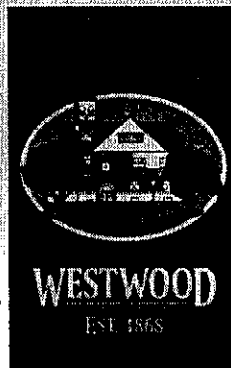
