There will be a demolition hearing on 7/31/15 for both of these properties.

Demolition of 2518 Queen City Avenue –

Motion by Joel Kimmet, seconded by Emily Miller-Reynolds to write a letter to the City opposing the demolition of 2518 Queen City Avenue because this house has historically significant relevance.

Discussion followed.

Motion further amended, with Mr. Kimmet in agreement, by I. McNulty, seconded by S. Schramm, adding to the motion by J. Kimmet that the City of Cincinnati be requested to move against the property owner of 2518 Queen City Avenue and take possession of this property because of its historical relevance.

All in favor, motion passed.

Demolition of 3077 Bracken Woods Lane –

Motion by J. Kimmet, seconded by I. McNulty that WCA write a letter to the City of Cincinnati supporting the demolition of 3077 Bracken Woods Lane, referencing the Westwood Strategic Plan as our basis.

Discussion followed.

There is no historical content or relevance here and problems with the property include blight, squatters and criminal activity. It was noted that the Cincinnati Police should be made well informed about this property.
