



The current CPD pilot procedure specifies the Body Worn Camera (BWC) be activated (at minimum) during the following types of incidents:

1. Any non-consensual encounter with a citizen
2. When on-scene with persons suspected of having mental health issues
3. While responding to calls for service in “emergency” mode (lights & siren activated)
4. During traffic pursuits and foot pursuits
5. Traffic stops, including the investigation of a vehicle and occupants already stopped or parked
6. All requests for consent to search without a warrant, including searches of persons, buildings, or vehicles
7. Requests for searches and deployments of drug-detection canines involving vehicles, when practical
8. Recordings of all persons physically arrested and being transported in any Department vehicle to any location
9. Officers have the discretion to activate the BWC when they believe an event may have evidentiary value
