

The current CPD pilot procedure specifies the Body Worn Camera (BWC) be activated (at minimum) during the following types of incidents:

- 1. Any non-consensual encounter with a citizen
- 2. When on-scene with persons suspected of having mental health issues
- 3. While responding to calls for service in "emergency" mode (lights & siren activated)
- 4. During traffic pursuits and foot pursuits
- 5. Traffic stops, including the investigation of a vehicle and occupants already stopped or parked
- 6. All requests for consent to search without a warrant, including searches of persons, buildings, or vehicles
- 7. Requests for searches and deployments of drug-detection canines involving vehicles, when practical
- 8. Recordings of all persons physically arrested and being transported in any Department vehicle to any location
- 9. Officers have the discretion to activate the BWC when they believe an event may have evidentiary value
