- NSP: NSP Funds need to be spent by the end of October. Steve Beckman provided a breakdown

 contact Sgt. Hicks to invite them to speak about recent shootings near Boudinot & Harrison at
 general meeting. John Kerr will also reach out to D3 to inquire about these incidents and any
 public information to share.
- Crosswalk requests to city Dept. of Transportation: Larry Eiser has compiled a list and
 coordinating requests with WestCurc to avoid overlap in requests. Both organizations are
 working to identify priority areas to recommend to city to install crosswalks and signals to
 improve pedestrian safety.
- 3. WCA organization: Discussion about need to set WCA priority issues and activities for coming year, how to engage more residents, and succession planning. Alexa will help schedule a date for a planning retreat.
- 4. Westwords: Anne Murphy will be taking over responsibility for assembling and publishing Westwords.
- 5. Ivory House parking issue: The city is planning to relocate a bus stop in front of the new Ivory House restaurant on Harrison Ave. that will impede parking in front of the business for pick-up/carry out. They are contacting the city to ask them to reconsider and seeking support from WCA and WestCurc.
